**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A725 Trunk Road (Raith) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Classes of Traffic and Pedestrians) Revocation Order 2019**

*Made* - - - - *2nd October 2019*

*Coming into force* - - *3rd October 2019*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1), 4(1), 14(1)(b) and (4) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of schedule 9 of, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A725 Trunk Road (Raith) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Classes of Traffic and Pedestrians) Revocation Order 2019 and comes into force on 3 October 2019.

**Revocation**

2. The A725 Trunk Road (Raith) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Classes of Traffic and Pedestrians) Order 2018(b) is revoked.
