Interpretation and expiry

**Interpretation**

**10.** In these Regulations—

“child” means a person who is under 16 years of age,

“constable” has the meaning given by section 99(1) of the Police and Fire Reform (Scotland) Act 2012<sup>(1)</sup>,

“a person who is responsible for carrying on a business” includes the owner, proprietor, and manager of that business,

“vulnerable person” includes—

- (a) any person aged 70 or older,
- (b) any person under 70 who has an underlying health condition, including but not limited to, the conditions listed in schedule 2,
- (c) any person who is pregnant.
