**The Fuel Poverty (Targets, Definition and Strategy)
(Scotland) Act 2019 (Scottish Fuel Poverty Advisory
Panel and Consequential Amendments) Regulations 2020**

Disqualification

3. An individual is disqualified from appointment, and from holding office, as a member if the individual—

- (a) is—
 - (i) a member of the Scottish Parliament,
 - (ii) a member of the House of Commons,
 - (iii) a member of the House of Lords,
 - (iv) a member of the National Assembly for Wales,
 - (v) a member of the Northern Ireland Assembly,
 - (vi) a member of the European Parliament,
 - (vii) a member of any local authority,
 - (viii) the holder of any other “relevant elective office” within the meaning of paragraph 1(8) of schedule 7 of the Political Parties, Elections and Referendums Act 2000⁽¹⁾,
 - (ix) a member of the Scottish Government,
 - (x) a Minister of the Crown,
 - (xi) an office-holder of the Crown in right of Her Majesty’s Government in the United Kingdom,
 - (xii) an office-holder in the Scottish Administration, or
 - (xiii) a civil servant,
- (b) is or has been disqualified from being a company director under the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986⁽²⁾,
- (c) is or has been disqualified from being a charity trustee under the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005⁽³⁾, or
- (d) is or has been disqualified under any disqualification provision analogous to either of those mentioned in sub-paragraphs (b) or (c), anywhere in the world.
