EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

Section 112A(1) of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 ("the Act") (as inserted by section 19 of the Transport (Scotland) Act 2005) provides for the Scottish Road Works Commissioner ("the Commissioner") to keep a register to be known as the Scottish Road Works Register ("the SRWR").

Section 112A(4) of the Act allows the Scottish Ministers, by regulations, to provide that the payment to the Commissioner of the prescribed fee is a condition of access to the SRWR.

Regulation 3(1) provides that, for the period from 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021, payment to the Commissioner of the prescribed fee by roads authorities and relevant undertakers is a condition of access to the SRWR as mentioned in section 112A(3) of the Act.

Regulation 3(5) and (6) provides formulas for the calculation of the prescribed fee for roads authorities and relevant undertakers respectively for the period from 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021.

Regulation 4 revokes the Scottish Road Works Register (Prescribed Fees) Regulations 2019.
