# **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A9 Trunk Road (Tain) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2021

Made---13th January 2021Coming into force-23rd January 2021

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section  $84(2)(\mathbf{b})$  of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations  $1987(\mathbf{c})$ .

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A9 Trunk Road (Tain) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2021 and comes into force on 23 January 2021.

#### Speed restriction

**2.** No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the schedule.

#### Exemption

3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

(a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(d) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations, or

## SCHEDULE

Article 2

### SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh – Stirling Thurso Trunk Road from a point 412 metres or thereby southeast of the extended centreline of the B9174 Knockbreck Road in a generally north westerly direction to a point 216 metres or thereby northwest of the extended centreline of the B9174 Morangie Road, a distance of 3.21 kilometres or thereby.
