The Social Security Information-sharing (Scotland) Regulations 2021

Made - - - - *24th March 2021*

Coming into force - - *26th July 2021*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 85(2)(g) and (5) and 95 of the Social Security (Scotland) Act 2018⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 96(2) of that Act, a draft of this instrument has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament.
