 - "(vi) 31 December 2022 in respect of appeals and complaints lodged in the period from 1 January 2020 to 31 March 2021.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends the Valuation Timetable (Scotland) Order 1995 ("the 1995 Order") which prescribes dates on which, and periods within which, various things require to be done in relation to a valuation roll.

Article 2 amends the schedule of the 1995 Order to extend the last date for the disposal by a valuation appeal committee of an appeal or complaint lodged with it between 1 January 2020 to 31 March 2021. That date is extended to 31 December 2022.
