The Social Security (Residence Requirements) (Afghanistan) (Scotland) Regulations 2021

Amendment of the Disability Assistance for Children and Young People (Scotland) Regulations 2021

- **6.**—(1) Regulation 5 of the Disability Assistance for Children and Young People (Scotland) Regulations 2021(1) is amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).
 - (2) After paragraph (10) insert—
 - "(10A) The habitual residence condition in paragraph (1)(b) and the past presence condition in paragraph (1)(e) do not apply where an individual—
 - (a) has leave to enter or remain in the United Kingdom granted under the immigration rules by virtue of—
 - (i) the Afghan Relocations and Assistance Policy, or
 - (ii) the previous scheme for locally-employed staff in Afghanistan (sometimes referred to as the ex-gratia scheme),
 - (b) has been granted discretionary leave outside the immigration rules as a dependant of a person referred to in sub-paragraph (a); or
 - (c) has leave granted under the Afghan Citizens Resettlement Scheme(2).".
 - (3) For paragraph (11) substitute—
 - "(11) For the purposes of paragraphs (10) and (10A)—
 - (a) "immigration rules" means the rules laid before Parliament under section 3(2) of the Immigration Act 1971(3),
 - (b) "the Afghan Citizens Resettlement Scheme" means the scheme announced by the United Kingdom Government on 18 August 2021(4).".
