**The Na h-Eileanan an Iar (Electoral Arrangements) Regulations 2021**

**Interpretation**

2.—(1) In these Regulations—

“the electoral ward map” for an individual electoral ward described in the table is the map held by Boundaries Scotland<sup>(1)</sup> marked with the following information—

- (a) the title of these Regulations, and
- (b) the name of the electoral ward,

“the Na h-Eileanan an Iar area map” means the map, showing the boundaries of all 11 electoral wards described in the table, which is held by Boundaries Scotland<sup>(2)</sup> and marked with the following information—

- (a) the title of these Regulations, and
- (b) the words “Map of all electoral wards in Na h-Eileanan an Iar”,

“the table” means the table in the schedule of these Regulations.

(2) In these Regulations, a reference to an electoral ward is a reference to that electoral ward as constituted by these Regulations.

(3) Where a boundary is shown on the Na h-Eileanan an Iar area map or the electoral ward map for any electoral ward as running along a road, railway line, footway, watercourse or similar geographical feature, it is to be treated as running along the centre line of the feature.
