**Amendment of schedule 8 – passenger notices**

7. In Part 1 of schedule 8 (passenger notices)—
- (a) before the paragraph beginning “Fill in your Passenger Locator Form”, insert as a new paragraph—

“All persons (including UK nationals and residents) arriving in the UK from outside the common travel area must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 2 days of departure to the UK. For further information please visit:  [- “1. Book PCR tests to be taken on or before day 2 and on or after day 8
  - 2. Complete a Passenger Locator Form
  - 3. Make plans to self-isolate in private accommodation for 10 full days after arrival \(or full duration of stay if less than 10 days\)”,](http://www.gov.scot/publications/coronavirus-covid-19-international-travel-quarantine/pages/pre-arrival-tests.”</a>”</p></li><li>(b) in the paragraph headed “Red list passengers (including passengers who are fully vaccinated)”, sub-paragraph 1 is omitted and sub-paragraphs 2 and 3 become sub-paragraphs 1 and 2 respectively,</li><li>(c) in the paragraph headed “Unvaccinated passengers or passengers vaccinated with unauthorised vaccines” for the sentences numbered 1, 2 and 3 substitute—<ul style=)
- (d) in the paragraph headed “Fully vaccinated passengers who are not red-list passengers” for the sentences numbered 1, 2 and 3 substitute—
  - “1. Book a PCR test to take on or before day 2
  - 2. Complete a Passenger Locator Form
  - 3. Self-isolate on arrival and until the result of your day 2 test is known. You may only leave self-isolation if the test is negative.”.
