Amendment of schedule 8 – passenger notices

7. In Part 1 of schedule 8 (passenger notices)—

(a) before the paragraph beginning "Fill in your Passenger Locator Form", insert as a new paragraph—

"All persons (including UK nationals and residents) arriving in the UK from outside the common travel area must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 2 days of departure to the UK. For further information please visit: www.gov.scot/publications/ coronavirus-covid-19-international-travel-quarantine/pages/pre-arrival-tests.",

- (b) in the paragraph headed "Red list passengers (including passengers who are fully vaccinated)", sub-paragraph 1 is omitted and sub-paragraphs 2 and 3 become sub-paragraphs 1 and 2 respectively,
- (c) in the paragraph headed "Unvaccinated passengers or passengers vaccinated with unauthorised vaccines" for the sentences numbered 1, 2 and 3 substitute—

"1. Book PCR tests to be taken on or before day 2 and on or after day 8

2. Compete a Passenger Locator Form

3. Make plans to self-isolate in private accommodation for 10 full days after arrival (or full duration of stay if less than 10 days)",

(d) in the paragraph headed "Fully vaccinated passengers who are not red-list passengers" for the sentences numbered 1, 2 and 3 substitute—

"1. Book a PCR test to take on or before day 2

2. Complete a Passenger Locator Form

3. Self-isolate on arrival and until the result of your day 2 test is known. You may only leave self-isolation if the test is negative.".
