# Amendment of the Food Information (Scotland) Regulations 2014

- 3.—(1) The Food Information (Scotland) Regulations 2014 MI are amended as follows.
- (2) After regulation 10A M2 (transitional provision) insert—

## "Transitional provision: withdrawal from the EU

- **10B.**—(1) A person is not considered to have failed to comply with Articles 7(1), 8(1), 9(1)(h) or 36(2)(a) or (b) of FIC if—
  - (a) the alleged failure relates to a product that was placed on the market before the last day of the period beginning on [F127 May 2021] and ending on 30 September 2022, and
  - (b) the matter constituting the alleged failure to comply would not have constituted a failure to comply with FIC as that Regulation had effect immediately before this regulation comes into force.
- (2) Products to which paragraph (1) applies may continue to be marketed until stocks are exhausted.".
