### SCHEDULE 1 Fees - Excepted Students

- 1. EU nationals etc. with protected rights who have been living in the UK for three years
- 2. Irish nationals who are settled in the United Kingdom
- 3. Family members of a relevant person of Northern Ireland
- 4. Workers, employed persons, self-employed persons and their family members
- 5. Workers who benefitted from the Freedom of Movement for Workers Regulation
- 6. Persons who are settled in the United Kingdom and have exercised a right of residence elsewhere
- 7. Refugees
- 8. Persons granted leave following on from refugee claim
- 9. Iraqi nationals
- 10. Syrian nationals
- 11. Afghan nationals
- 12. Relocated Afghan citizens
- 13. Ukrainian nationals

- 14. Persons granted stateless leave
- 15. Persons granted discretionary leave to remain as a victim of modern slavery
- 16. Persons granted indefinite leave to remain as a victim of domestic violence or domestic abuse
- 17. Persons granted Calais leave
- 18. Persons who are children of asylum seekers and young asylum seekers
- 19. Children of Swiss nationals
- 20. Children of Turkish workers

### SCHEDULE 2 Ordinary Residence

- 1. Students with a relevant connection with Scotland: ordinary residence on relevant date
- 2. Ordinary residence for specified period: general
- 3. Ordinary residence for specified period: exclusion for educational purposes
- 4. Ordinary residence for specified period: residence requirements for students born in the relevant area
- 5. Ordinary residence for specified period: temporary absence for employment or study
