SCHEDULE 1 PERSONS ELIGIBLE FOR STUDENT SUPPORT
PART 1 PERSONS ELIGIBLE FOR TUITION FEE
AND LIVING COST SUPPORT

- 2. EU nationals etc. with protected rights who have been living in the UK and Islands for three years
- 3. Irish nationals who are settled in the United Kingdom
