Alcohol licensing: saving provision

- 10.—(1) Subject to paragraph (3) below, paragraph 4(1) and (2) of schedule 5 of the first Scottish Act continue in effect in relation to the requirement that a Licensing Board must, not later than 9 months after the end of the financial year, prepare and publish a report in terms of section 9A(1)(1) of the 2005 Act.
- (2) Subject to paragraph (3) below, paragraph 4(1) and (3) of schedule 5 of the first Scottish Act continue in effect in relation to the requirement that a Licensing Board must, not later than 9 months after the end of the financial year, prepare and publish a report in terms of section 9B(1)(2) of the 2005 Act.
- (3) Paragraphs (1) and (2) apply only in respect of reports relating to the financial year that ended on 31 March 2022.
