**The Valuation (Proposals Procedure)  
(Scotland) Regulations 2022**

**Acknowledgement of proposal**

7.—(1) Subject to paragraphs (3) and (4) and to regulation 17, the assessor must send to the proposer an acknowledgment, in writing, of receipt of the proposal, within the period of 56 days beginning with the day on which the proposal is presumed to have been received by the assessor.

(2) The assessor must provide the following information with the acknowledgement of receipt—

- (a) the date on which the assessor received the proposal, and
- (b) the date of issue of the acknowledgement.

(3) Paragraph (1) does not apply where an assessor decides that a proposal is incomplete and issues a notice under regulation 6(2).

(4) Where a proposal has been the subject of a notice under regulation 6(2) but has subsequently been considered to be complete, an acknowledgement of the proposal, in writing, must be sent to the proposer within the period of 7 days beginning with the day on which the decision is made that the proposal is complete.

(5) An acknowledgement under paragraph (4) must confirm that the proposal is now being considered.

(6) For the purposes of this regulation a proposal is to be presumed to have been received by the assessor 48 hours after it was sent.
