The Parole Board (Scotland) Rules 2022

The Scottish Ministers make the following Rules in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 20(4), (4A) and (4B) of the Prisoners and Criminal Proceedings (Scotland) Act 1993⁽¹⁾, and all other powers enabling them to do so.
