The Red Rocks and Longay Urgent Marine Conservation (No. 2) Order 2021 (Urgent Continuation) Order 2022

Made - - - - - 1st February 2022

Laid before the Scottish Parliament 3rd February 2022

Coming into force - - 16th March 2022

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 88(6) of the Marine (Scotland) Act 2010(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 88(7) of that Act, the Scottish Ministers intend to make a marine conservation order (a "permanent order") in respect of the Red Rocks and Longay MPA(\mathbf{b}) (in accordance with the requirements of section 87 of that Act), and they have published notice of their proposal to make the permanent order(\mathbf{c}).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Red Rocks and Longay Urgent Marine Conservation (No. 2) Order 2021 (Urgent Continuation) Order 2022 and comes into force on 16 March 2022.
