The Lews Castle College (Transfer and Closure) (Scotland) Order 2023

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 3(1)(c), 25(1)(a), (1A), (2)(f) and (5) and 60(3) of the Further and Higher Education (Scotland) Act 1992⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 5(1) of that Act, they have consulted the education authority for the area in which Lews Castle College is situated, the persons mentioned in section 5(1A) of that Act⁽²⁾ and any other person appearing to them to be affected by the proposal.

In accordance with section 25(7) of that Act⁽³⁾, the Board of Management of The North Highland College has consented to the transfer and vesting of property, rights, liabilities and obligations provided for in this Order.
