## **SPORTS GROUNDS AND SPORTING EVENTS**

The Sports Grounds and Sporting Events (Designation) (Scotland) Amendment Order 2023

Made	7th September 2023
Laid before the Scottish Parliament	11th September 2023
Coming into force	6th November 2023

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 18 of the Criminal Law (Consolidation) (Scotland) Act 1995(**a**) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Sports Grounds and Sporting Events (Designation) (Scotland) Amendment Order 2023 and comes into force on 6 November 2023.

# Amendment of the Sports Grounds and Sporting Events (Designation) (Scotland) Order 2014

**2.**—(1) The Sports Grounds and Sporting Events (Designation) (Scotland) Order 2014(**b**) is amended as follows.

(2) In schedule 1 (sports grounds)-

(a) omit the following entries—

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

#### (This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Sports Grounds and Sporting Events (Designation) (Scotland) Order 2014 ("the 2014 Order"). The 2014 Order designates sports grounds, classes of sporting events played at those grounds and classes of sporting events outside Great Britain for the purposes of Part II of the Criminal Law (Consolidation) (Scotland) Act 1995 (sporting events: control of alcohol etc.).

Article 2(2) of this Order makes changes to the list of sports grounds designated in the 2014 Order, to reflect changes to the membership of the football leagues for which the home grounds of member clubs were designated in the 2014 Order.

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
