# The Food (Scotland) Act 2015 (Compliance Notices) Amendment Regulations 2023

Made - - - - - 7th November 2023

Laid before the Scottish Parliament 9th November 2023

Coming into force - - 21st December 2023

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 49(1) and (2)(c), and 52 of the Food (Scotland) Act 2015(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

The Scottish Ministers have had regard to relevant advice given by Food Standards Scotland in accordance with section 50(1)(a) of the Food (Scotland) Act 2015.

There has been consultation as required by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety(**b**).

#### Citation and commencement

- **1.**—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Food (Scotland) Act 2015 (Compliance Notices) Amendment Regulations 2023.
  - (2) These Regulations come into force on 21 December 2023.

## Amendment of the Food (Scotland) Act 2015 (Compliance Notices) Regulations 2023

**2.**—(1) The Food (Scotland) Act 2015 (Compliance Notices) Regulations 2023(c) are amended as follows.
