



Parochial Church Councils (Powers) Measure 1956

1956 No. 3 4 and 5 Eliz 2

1 Definitions.

In this Measure—

“Council” means a parochial church council;

“Diocesan Authority” means the Diocesan Board of Finance or any existing or future body appointed by the [^{F1}Diocesan Synod] to act as trustees of diocesan trust property;

[^{F2}“Minister” has the meaning given in Rule 83 of the Church Representation Rules;]

[^{F2}“Parish” has the meaning given in Rule 82 of those Rules;]

“Relevant date” means the first day of July, 1921.
