Part I — (Individuals in additional public authorities that may acquire all types of communications data within section 21(4) of the 2000 Act)

Part II — (Individuals in the public authorities specified in Part I that may only acquire communications data falling within sections 21(4)(b) and (c) of the 2000 Act)
