The Environmental Permitting  
(England and Wales) Regulations 2007

PART 7

Miscellaneous and transitional provision, savings,  
consequential amendments, revocations and repeals

**Interpretation of this Part**

67. In this Part—

- “at the relevant time” means immediately before the coming into force of these Regulations;  
“disposal licence” means a disposal licence issued under section 5 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974<sup>(1)</sup>;  
“PPC permit” means a permit granted under regulation 10 of the 2000 Regulations<sup>(2)</sup>;  
“transitional application” means an application mentioned in regulation 70(1)(c) or (d) or to which regulation 71 applies; and  
“waste management licence” means a licence granted under section 35 of the 1990 Act<sup>(3)</sup>.
