



(1) “the Bank” means the African Development Bank established by an agreement dated 4th August 1963, as ratified by the Government on 29th April 1983(a);

“the Fund” means the African Development Fund of the Bank established by an agreement dated 29th November 1972, as ratified by the Government on 30th June 1973(b);

“the Government” means the Government of the United Kingdom;

“the Resolution” means Resolution F/BG/2008/01 dated 28th March 2008 of the Board of Governors of the Fund.

### **Relevant Payments**

3. The Secretary of State may, on behalf of the Government—

(a) make payment of a further contribution to the Fund not exceeding £417,000,000 in accordance with arrangements made between the Government and the Fund in accordance with the Resolution; and

(b) make payment of sums required to redeem any non-interest-bearing and non-negotiable notes or other obligations which may be issued or created by the Secretary of State and accepted by the Fund in accordance with the arrangements mentioned in paragraph (a),

in accordance with section 11 of the International Development Act 2002.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order approves the making of payments on behalf of the Government of the United Kingdom of sums not exceeding £417,000,000 as a further contribution to the resources of the African Development Fund in accordance with the arrangements made pursuant to Resolution F/BG/2008/01 adopted by the Board of Governors of the African Development Fund on 28th March 2008.

The Order further approves the redemption of non-interest-bearing and non-negotiable notes issued by the Secretary of State in payment of the further contribution.

An impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no impact on the private or voluntary sectors is foreseen.
