**The Welsh Ministers (Transfer of Functions) (No. 2) Order 2009**

**Transfer of functions**

**2.** The following functions are, so far as exercisable in relation to Wales, transferred to the Welsh Ministers—

- (a) functions conferred or imposed on the Secretary of State by or under the 1984 Act<sup>(1)</sup>, subject to articles 3 and 4;
- (b) functions of the Secretary of State under—
  - (i) section 6 of the Sustainable and Secure Buildings Act 2004<sup>(2)</sup> (Secretary of State to report on building stock); and
  - (ii) section 14 of the Climate Change and Sustainable Energy Act 2006<sup>(3)</sup> (report regarding compliance).
