PART 1

General

Interpretation: Directives

3. In these Regulations—

“the Waste Framework Directive” means Directive [2006/12/EC](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council on waste(**7**);

“the Waste Incineration Directive” means Directive [2000/76/EC](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council on the incineration of waste(**8**);
