**The Charities Act 2006 (Principal Regulators
of Exempt Charities) Regulations 2011**

Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1

These Regulations are made in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 10B(4) and (5) of the Charities Act 1993⁽¹⁾ and sections 13(4)(b) and (5) and 74(2) of the Charities Act 2006⁽²⁾.

A draft of these Regulations has been laid before Parliament in accordance with section 74(5) of the Charities Act 2006 and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament.

Accordingly, the Minister for the Cabinet Office makes the following Regulations:
