CHAPTER 6

MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS RELATING TO APPEALS

Child support appeals involving issues that arise in other cases

- **29.** The circumstances prescribed for the purposes of section 28ZB(6)(c) of the 1991 Act(1) (appeals involving issues that arise on appeal in other cases) are where the Secretary of State—
 - (a) certifies in writing that an appeal against the decision in question is being considered; and
 - (b) considers that, if such an appeal were already determined, it would affect the determination of the appeal described in section 28ZB(1)(a) of that Act.

⁽¹⁾ Section 28ZB was inserted by section 43 of the Social Security Act 1998 (c.14). Subsection (6) concerns the situation where, in prescribed circumstances, an appeal against a decision in a case has not been brought, or an application for leave to appeal has not been made, but the time for doing so has not expired.
