**The Copyright and Rights in Performances
(Quotation and Parody) Regulations 2014**

Made - - - - 2014

Coming into force - - 1st October 2014

The Secretary of State is a Minister designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972⁽¹⁾ in relation to matters relating to copyright and rights in performances⁽²⁾.

In accordance with paragraph 2(2) of Schedule 2 to that Act, a draft of this instrument was laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of that Act makes the following Regulations:
