The Harrogate Stray Act 1985 (Tour de Yorkshire) Order 2016

Made - - - - ***

Coming into force in accordance with article 1

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(1), (5)(b) and (6) of the Localism Act 2011(1), makes the following Order.

The Secretary of State considers that provisions of, or made under, the Harrogate Stray Act 1985(2) prevent or restrict the general power conferred by section 1 of the Localism Act 2011 which Harrogate Borough Council seeks to exercise for the purpose specified in this Order.

The Secretary of State considers the conditions contained within section 6(2) of the Localism Act 2011 are satisfied.

The Secretary of State has consulted in accordance with section 5(7) of the Localism Act 2011 and has, following this consultation and in accordance with section 7(2) of the Localism Act 2011, laid a draft Order and explanatory document before Parliament.

Pursuant to section 15 of the Legislative and Regulatory Reform Act 2006(**3**), the negative resolution procedure (within the meaning of Part 1 of that Act) applies in relation to the making of the Order.

Neither House of Parliament resolved within the 40-day period referred to in section 16(3) of that Act that the Secretary of State should not make the Order(4).
