Wards of the city of Manchester and number of councillors

- (w) Moss Side;
- (x) Moston;
- (y) Northenden;
- (z) Old Moat;
- (aa) Piccadilly;
- (bb) Rusholme;

- (dd) Whalley Range;
 - (ee) Withington;
 - (ff) Woodhouse Park;
- (3) Each ward comprises the area identified on the map by reference to the name of the ward.
- (4) Three councillors are to be elected for each ward.
