The Recognition of Professional Qualifications
(Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2018

Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1

The Secretary of State is designated(1) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(2) (“the 1972 Act”) in relation to recognition of higher education diplomas, formal qualifications, or experience in the occupation, required for the pursuit of professions or occupations.

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the 1972 Act, section 132(1) and (2) of the Education Act 2002(3) and section 8(1) of, and paragraph 21(b) of Schedule 7 to, the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018(4) (“the 2018 Act”).

In accordance with paragraph 1(3) of Schedule 7 to the 2018 Act, a draft of this instrument has been laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.

The 1972 Act is repealed with effect from exit day by section 1 of the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018.
