# The Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order 2020

### PART 2

#### SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS AND PENSIONS

## Increase in rate of graduated retirement benefit

- 12.—(1) In section 36(1) of the National Insurance Act 1965(1) (graduated retirement benefit)—
  - (a) the sum of "14.16" pence shall be increased by 1.7 per cent; and
  - (b) the reference to that sum shall have effect as a reference to "14.40" pence.
- (2) The sums which are the increases of graduated retirement benefit under Schedule 2 to the Social Security (Graduated Retirement Benefit) (No. 2) Regulations 1978(2) (increases for deferred retirement) shall be increased by 1.7 per cent.
- (3) The sums which are lump sums to which surviving spouses or civil partners will become entitled under Schedule 1 to the Social Security (Graduated Retirement Benefit) Regulations 2005(3) (increases of graduated retirement benefit and lump sums) shall be increased by 1.7 per cent.
- (4) The sums which are the additions under section 37(1) of the National Insurance Act 1965 (additions for widows and widowers) shall be increased by 1.7 per cent.
