### 1966 CHAPTER xxii

An Act to regulate the expenditure on capital account and on lending to other persons by the Greater London Council during the financial period from 1st April 1966 to 30th September 1967; and for other purposes.

[9th August 1966]

HEREAS the borrowing of money by the Greater London Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") for the purposes of expenditure on capital account or on lending to other persons is governed by the Local Government 1933 c. 51. Act 1933 and the London Government Act 1963 and by Acts 1963 c. 33. to be obtained by the Council for regulating such expenditure during any financial year (that is to say, a period of twelve months ending on 31st March) and the immediately following six months:

And whereas such financial year and the immediately following six months are in the London Government Act 1963 together referred to as a "financial period":

And whereas such expenditure as aforesaid is, in relation to the financial period ending on 30th September 1966, regulated by the Greater London Council (Money) Act 1965:

And whereas it is expedient that the expenditure by the Council on capital account and on lending to other persons during the financial period from 1st April 1966 to 30th September 1967 (hereinafter referred to as "the financial period 1966-1967") should be regulated as by this Act provided:

And whereas estimates have been prepared by the various committees of the Council of the amounts which may be required for the purposes of expenditure on capital account and on lending to other persons during the financial period 1966-1967 in the execution of the powers and duties respectively delegated to those committees; and all those estimates have been considered by the finance committee of the Council and submitted by that committee to the Council and the estimates as so submitted have been adopted by the Council:

And whereas an estimate has been approved by the Inner London Education Authority of the amount which the said Authority may require in respect of expenditure on capital account during the financial period 1966-1967:

And whereas the sums estimated to be so required as aforesaid for expenditure on capital account during the financial period 1966-1967 are set out in Part I of the schedule to this Act:

And whereas the sums estimated to be so required as aforesaid for expenditure on lending to other persons by the Council during the financial period 1966-1967 are set out in Part II of the said schedule:

And whereas the further sums which the Treasury in pursuance of the London Government Act 1963 may authorise the Council to expend on capital account and on lending to other persons during the financial period 1966-1967 are set out in Part III of the said schedule:

And whereas the objects of this Act cannot be attained without the authority of Parliament:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and construction.

1. This Act may be cited as the Greater London Council (Money) Act 1966.

Interpretation.

2.—(1) In and for the purposes of this Act—

"the Act of 1963" means the London Government Act 1963:

"the Council" means the Greater London Council;

"the financial period 1966-1967" means the period from 1st April 1966 to 30th September 1967, both dates inclusive;

"the financial year" means the period from 1st April 1966 to 31st March 1967, both dates inclusive;

"the immediately following six months" means the period from 1st April 1967 to 30th September 1967, both dates inclusive;

"the schedule" means the schedule to this Act.

- (2) In the schedule references to any enactment shall be construed as references to that enactment as amended, extended or applied by any other enactment.
- 3.—(1) The purposes for which during the financial period Expenditure 1966-1967 the Council may under the powers of the Act of 1963 on capital account expend money on capital account shall be the purposes mentioned during in the second column of Part I of the schedule.

financial 1966-1967.

- (2) The sums which during the said financial period the Council period may under the said powers expend on capital account shall, as regards the financial year and the immediately following six months, be sums which, except as otherwise provided by the Act of 1963, shall not exceed those specified in the third and fourth columns respectively of Part I of the schedule in relation to the said purposes.
- 4.—(1) The persons to whom the Council may, under the Loans to powers of the Act of 1963, lend money during the financial period persons during 1966-1967, and who may under those powers borrow from the financial Council during that financial period shall be the persons 1966-1967. mentioned in the first column of Part II of the schedule.
- (2) The sums which during the said financial period may be so lent and borrowed shall, as regards the financial year and the immediately following six months, be sums which, except as otherwise provided by the Act of 1963, shall not exceed those specified in the second and third columns respectively of Part II of the schedule in relation to the said persons.
- 5. The sums which the Council may be authorised by the Sums which Treasury under the powers of the Act of 1963 to expend on capital Treasury may account and on lending to other persons during the financial period authorise in 1966-1967, in case the amounts specified in Parts I and II af the case of 1966-1967, in case the amounts specified in Parts I and II of the insufficiency. schedule or any of those amounts are found to be insufficient shall, as regards the financial year and the immediately following six months, be sums not exceeding in the aggregate the amounts specified in the second and third columns respectively of Part III of the schedule.

6. It shall not be lawful for the Council to exercise for the Saving. purposes mentioned in the foregoing provisions of this Act the powers of borrowing conferred by the Act of 1963 otherwise than in compliance with the provisions for the time being in force of any order made under section 1 of the Borrowing 1946 c. 58. (Control and Guarantees) Act 1946.
