1966 CHAPTER iii

An Act to confirm Provisional Orders of the Minister of Housing and Local Government relating to the City of Cambridge and the county boroughs of Reading and Walsall.
[3rd August 1966]

WHEREAS under the provisions of one or more of the Public Health Act 1875, the Public Health Act 1936 and the Food and Drugs Act 1955 the Minister of Housing and Local Government has made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto which need confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The orders of the Minister of Housing and Local Government which are set out in the schedule to this Act are hereby confirmed and shall have full validity and force.

Confirmation of orders in schedule.

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Housing and Local Government Provisional Orders Confirmation (Cambridge, Reading and Walsall) Act 1966.

SCHEDULE

CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

PROVISIONAL ORDER AMENDING A LOCAL ACT AND A CONFIRMING ACT

1875 c. 55. The Minister of Housing and Local Government, on the application of the Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Cambridge and in exercise of his powers under sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement. 1. This order may be cited as the City of Cambridge Order 1966 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Interpretation. 2. In this order—
1850 c. xxxvii. “the Act of 1850” means the Cambridge Corporation Act 1850;
“the City” means the City of Cambridge;
“the Corporation” means the mayor, aldermen and citizens of the City;
“the Fair” means the Fair of Barnwell commonly known as the Midsummer Fair; and
“the Minister” means the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Fair stallages, rents and tolls. 3. The Corporation may, with the approval of the Minister, from time to time alter or add to the stallages, rents and tolls specified, in respect of all Fairs within the City, and also the Fair at Reach, in Schedule (C.) to the Act of 1850 as amended by article 1 of and Schedule A to the Cambridge Order 1912, in so far as they apply to the Fair, and any such altered stallages, rents or tolls shall, as from the date on which they come into operation, be substituted in their application to the Fair for the corresponding stallages, rents or tolls payable under the said Schedule (C.) as so amended.

Duration of Fair. 4.—(1) The Fair shall commence at 2.30 o'clock in the afternoon (or such earlier hour as may be proclaimed by the Mayor of the City) on the third Wednesday in June, or, if the third Wednesday falls on 15th, 16th or 17th June, on the fourth Wednesday in June and shall continue for the four days (exclusive of Sunday) next following the day of commencement and no longer.

(2) Section 32 of the Act of 1850 is hereby repealed.

Local inquiries. 5.—(1) The Minister may cause such local inquiry to be held as he may consider necessary for the purpose of any of his functions under this order.

COUNTY BOROUGH OF READING

PROVISIONAL ORDER AMENDING A LOCAL ACT

The Minister of Housing and Local Government, on the application of the council of the county borough of Reading and in exercise of his powers under section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875, section 317 of the Public Health Act 1936 and section 131 of the Food and Drugs Act 1955 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Reading Order 1966 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it. Citation and commencement.
2. In this order— Interpretation.
 - “ the Corporation ” means the mayor, aldermen and burgesses of the borough of Reading; and
 - “ the Minister ” means the Minister of Housing and Local Government.
3. The Corporation may, with the approval of the Minister, from time to time alter or add to the tolls specified in Schedule (C.) to the Reading Corporation Markets Act 1853, and any such altered tolls shall, as from the date on which they come into operation, be substituted for the corresponding tolls payable under the said schedule. COUNTY BOROUGH OF WALSALL

PROVISIONAL ORDER ALTERING A LOCAL ACT

The Minister of Housing and Local Government, on the application of the council of the county borough of Walsall and in exercise of his powers under section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875, section 317 of the Public Health Act 1936 and section 131 of the Food and Drugs Act 1955 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Walsall Order 1966 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it. Citation and commencement.
2. In this order— Interpretation.
 - “ the Act of 1850 ” means the Walsall Improvement and Market Amendment Act 1850 as remaining in force by virtue of section 16 of the Walsall Gas Purchase and Borough Extension Act 1876 and set out in Part II of Schedule 6 to the said Act of 1876; 1850 c. xv.
1876 c. cxix.

“ the Corporation ” means the mayor, aldermen and burgesses of the borough of Walsall;

“ the pig market ” means the land described as being within the limits of the pig market in section XX of the Act of 1850.

Amendment of

3.—(1) Nothing contained in section XXI of the Act of 1850 or in any byelaw made thereunder shall prevent the exercise by the Corporation in relation to the pig market of any of the powers for the time being vested in them (whether under the Local Government Act 1933 or otherwise) as to the appropriation, use or disposal of land.

(2) On the exercise of any power referred to in this article, the provisions of section XIV of the Act of 1850 shall cease to have effect in relation to the pig market.

(3) Section XXI of the Act of 1850 is hereby repealed.
