1973 CHAPTER xxxiii

An Act to regulate the expenditure on capital account and on lending to other persons by the Greater London Council during the financial period from 1st April 1973 to 30th September 1974; and for other purposes.

[25th July 1973]

WHEREAS the London Government Act 1963 requires 1963 c. 33. that expenditure by the Greater London Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") on capital account or on lending to other persons shall be regulated by annual money Acts and that each of such Acts shall make provision for a period consisting of a financial year (that is to say a period of twelve months ending on 31st March) and the immediately following six months:

And whereas such a financial year and the immediately following six months are in the London Government Act 1963 and hereinafter together referred to as a "financial period":

And whereas such expenditure as aforesaid is, in relation to the financial period ending on 30th September 1973, regulated by the Greater London Council (Money) Act 1972: 1972 c. xxvii.

And whereas it is expedient that the expenditure by the Council on capital account and on lending to other persons during the financial period from 1st April 1973 to 30th September 1974 (hereinafter referred to as "the financial period 1973-1974") should be regulated as by this Act provided:

And whereas estimates have been prepared by the various committees of the Council of the amounts which may be required for the purposes of expenditure on capital account and on lending to other persons during the financial period 1973-1974 in the

execution of the powers and duties respectively delegated to those committees; and all those estimates have been considered by the policy and resources committee of the Council and submitted by that committee to the Council and the estimates as so submitted have been adopted by the Council:

And whereas an estimate has been approved by the Inner London Education Authority of the amount which the said Authority may require in respect of expenditure on capital account during the financial period 1973-1974:

And whereas the sums estimated to be so required as aforesaid for expenditure on capital account during the financial period 1973-1974 are the amounts specified in Part I of the schedule to this Act:

And whereas the sums estimated to be so required as aforesaid for expenditure on lending to other persons by the Council during the financial period 1973-1974 are the amounts specified in Part II of the said schedule:

1963 c. 33. And whereas the further sums which the Treasury in pursuance of the London Government Act 1963 may authorise the Council to expend on capital account and on lending to other persons during the financial period 1973-1974 are set out in Part III of the said schedule:

And whereas the objects of this Act cannot be attained without the authority of Parliament:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Greater London Council (Money) Act 1973.

Interpretation. 2.—(1) In and for the purposes of this Act—
 “the Act of 1963” means the London Government Act 1963;
 “the Council” means the Greater London Council;
 “the financial period 1973-1974” means the period from 1st April 1973 to 30th September 1974, both dates inclusive;
 “the financial year” means the period from 1st April 1973 to 31st March 1974, both dates inclusive;
 “the immediately following six months” means the period from 1st April 1974 to 30th September 1974, both dates inclusive;
 “the schedule” means the schedule to this Act.

(2) In the schedule references to any enactment shall be construed as references to that enactment as amended, extended or applied by any other enactment.

3.—(1) The purposes for which during the financial period 1973-1974 the Council may under the powers of the Act of 1963 expend money on capital account shall be the purposes mentioned in the second column of Part I of the schedule.

Expenditure on capital account during financial period 1973-1974.

(2) The sums which during the said financial period the Council may under the said powers expend on capital account shall, as regards the financial year and the immediately following six months, be sums which, except as otherwise provided by the Act of 1963, shall not exceed the amounts specified in the third and fourth columns respectively of Part I of the schedule in relation to the said purposes.

4.—(1) The persons to whom the Council may, under the powers of the Act of 1963, lend money during the financial period 1973-1974, and who may under those powers borrow from the Council during that financial period shall be the persons mentioned in the first column of Part II of the schedule.

Loans to persons during financial period 1973-1974.

(2) The sums which during the said financial period may be so lent and borrowed shall, as regards the financial year and the immediately following six months, be sums which, except as otherwise provided by the Act of 1963, shall not exceed the amounts specified in the second and third columns respectively of Part II of the schedule in relation to the said persons.

5. The sums which the Council may be authorised by the Treasury under the powers of the Act of 1963 to expend on capital account and on lending to other persons during the financial period 1973-1974, in case the amounts specified in Parts I and II of the schedule or any of those amounts are found to be insufficient shall, as regards the financial year and the immediately following six months, be sums not exceeding in the aggregate the amounts specified in the second and third columns respectively of Part III of the schedule.

Sums which Treasury may authorise in case of insufficiency.

6. Nothing in this Act shall be construed as authorising—

Saving.

(a) the Council to exercise the powers of borrowing conferred by the Local Government Act 1933 or by the Local Government Act 1972, as the case may be; or

(b) any of the persons mentioned in the first column of Part II of the schedule to borrow money;

in contravention of any order made under section 1 of the Borrowing (Control and Guarantees) Act 1946.
