An Act for effectuating an Exchange of the Advowfon of the Rectory of the Church of South Cove
in the County of Suffolk, belonging to His Majesty, for the Advowson of the Rectory of the
Church of Depding otherwise Depden, in the same
County, belonging to Sir Thomas Gooch Baronet.

[22d July 1812.]

HEREAS the Parish of South Cove in the County of Suffolk is situated near to, and in great Part surrounded by the Estate of Sir Thomas Gooch of Benacre Hall, in the said County, Baronet, situate in Benacre, Bentham, and Covehithe in the said County, and a considerable Part of the Land in the said Parish of South Cove is the Property of the said Sir Thomas Gooch: And whereas His Majesty, in Right of His Crown, is seised in Fee Simple of the Advowson of the Rectory and Parish Church of the said Parish of South Cove; but the same Rectory being under Value, the Right of Presentation thereto hath been heretofore in the Lord High Chancellor, or Lord Keeper, or Lords Commissioners of the Great Seal of Great Britain for the Time being, and the said Rectory is situated in the Diocese of Norwich: And whereas the said Sir Thomas Gooch is seised in Fee Simple of the Advowson or Right of Patronage and Presentation of and to the Rectory and Parish Church of Depding otherwise Depden in the said C ounty of Suffolk and Diocese of Norwich, which Rectory is of considerably greater Annual Value than the said Rectory of South Cove; but from the Vicinity of the faid Parish of South Cove to the said Sir Thomas Gooch's Residence and Family Estate, ne the said Sir Thomas Gooch is desirous of obtaining the Advowson of the said Rectory of South Cove in Exchange for the Advowson of the said Rectory of Depding otherwise Depden; but such Exchange cannot be effected without the Aid and Authority of Parliament; wherefore Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal Subject the said Sir [Loc. & Per.] Thomas

of Depden vested in His Majesty.

Thomas Gooch, doth most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority Rectory, &c. of the same, That from and immediately after the passing of this Act, all that the Advowson and Right of Patronage of, in, and to the said Rectory and Parish Church of Depding otherwise Depden in the County of Suffolk, shall be vested in and settled upon, and the same is hereby from henceforth vested in and settled upon His Majesty and His Heirs and Successors for ever, to the Use of His Majesty and His Heirs and Successors for ever, in lieu of and in Exchange for the said Advowson of the Rectory and Parish Church of South Cove in the said County of Suffolk, and the Right of Patronage and Presentation of, in, and to the same hereinafter expressed to be hereby vested in and settled upon the said Sir Thomas Gooch and his Heirs and Assigns for ever.

Presentation to Depden vested in the Lord Chancellor.

II. Provided always, and it is hereby enacted, That the Right of Presentation of and to the said Rectory and Parish Church of Depding otherwise Depden, shall from and after the passing of this Act, from Time to Time, as the same shall by Death, Cession, Surrender, or otherwise become void, be vested in and the same is hereby vested in the Lord High Chancellor, Lord Keeper, or Lords Commissioners of the Great Seal of Great Britain for the Time being, in such and the same Manner as the Presentation of, in, and to the said Rectory and Parish Church of South Cove hath heretofore been, or would hereafter have been in case this Act had not been made; any Thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding.

Advowson and Right of Presentation of and to South Cove vested in Sir Thomas Gooch.

III. And be it further enacted, That all that the Advowson and Right of Patronage and Presentation of, in, and to the said Rectory and Parish Church of South Cove in the said County of Suffolk, shall from and immediately after the passing of this Act be vested in and settled upon, and the same are hereby from thenceforth vested in and settled upon the said Sir Thomas Gooch and his Heirs and Assigns for ever, to the Use of him the said Sir Thomas Gooch and his Heirs and Assigns for ever, in lieu of and in Exchange for the said Advowson and Right of Patronage and Presentation of, in, and to the said Rectory and Parish Church of Depding otherwise Depden.

Eviction of the Crown or Lord Chancellor.

IV. Provided always, and it is hereby enacted, That in case His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, shall at any Time hereafter be evicted from the Possession and Enjoyment of the said Advowson and Right of Patronage of, in, and to the said Rectory and Parish Church of Depding otherwise Depden, herein-before vested in His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, as aforesaid; or if the Lord High Chancellor, or Lord Keeper, or Lords Commissioners of the Great Seal of Great Britain for the Time being, shall at any Time hereafter be evicted from the peaceable and quiet Right of Presentation of, in, and to the same Rectory and Parish Church, by or through any Defect of Title of the said Sir Thomas Gooch, then and in such Case it shall be lawful for His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, immediately after such his or their Eviction, to reclaim and recover back the said Advowson and Right of Patronage of, in, and to the Rectory and Parish Church of South Cove, so vested in the said Sir Thomas Goodh

and his Heirs and Assigns, and the same and every Part thereof to have again, re-possess, and enjoy, as in his and their former Estate; and also to and for the Lord High Chancellor, or Lord Keeper, or Lords Commissioners of the Great Seal of Great Britain for the Time being, to reclaim and recover back the said Right of Presentation of, in, and to the same Rectory and Parish Church, and the same to have again, re-posses, and enjoy, as in his and their former Estate, without any Suit, Trouble, Interruption, or Disturbance of, from, or by the said Sir Thomas Gooch or his Heirs, or any Person or Persons claiming or to claim by, from, or under him, them, or any of them.

V. Provided also, and it is hereby enacted, That in case the said Sir Eviction of Thomas Gooch or his Heirs, or any Person or Persons who shall claim any Sir Thomas Estate, Right, Title, or Interest by, from, or under him, them, or any of them, of, in, to, or out of the faid Advowson and Right of Patronage and Presentation of, in, and to the said Rectory and Parish Church of South Cove, so vested in him the said Sir Thomas Gooch, his Heirs and Assigns as aforesaid, or any Part thereof, shall at any Time hereaster be evicted from the Possession and Enjoyment of the same Advowson and Right of Patronage and Presentation of, in, and to the said Rectory and Parish Church of South Cove, or any Part thereof, by or through any Defect of the Title of His Majesty or his Predecessors, or by any Person or Persons whomsoever claiming or to claim by, from, or under His Majesty or His Successors, or by any Defect of the Title of the Lord High Chancellor, Lord Keeper, or Lords Commissioners of the Great Seal of Great Britain for the Time being, then and in such Case it shall be lawful for the said Sir Thomas Gooch and his Heirs and Assigns, immediately after such Eviction to reclaim and recover back the said Advowson and Right of Patronage and Presentation of, in, and to the said Rectory and Parish Church of Depding otherwise Depden, and the same and every Part thereof to have again, re-possess, and re-enjoy, as in his and their former Estate, without any Suit, Trouble, Interruption, or Disturbance of, from, or by His Majesty or His Heirs or Successors, or the Lord High Chancellor, or Lord Keeper, or the Lords Commissioners of the Great Seal of Great Britain for the Time being.

VI. Saving always unto all and every Person and Persons and Bodies General Politic and Corporate, (other than His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, Saving. and also other than the Lord High Chancellor, Lord Keeper, and Lords Commissioners of the Great Seal of Great Britain for the Time being, and the said Sir Thomas Gooch and his Heirs and Assigns), all such Estate, Right, Title, Interest, Claim, and Demand of, in, and to and out of the faid Advowsons or Rights of Patronage and Presentation hereby vested and settled as aforesaid, as they, every, or any of them had before the passing of this Act, or could or might have had, held, or enjoyed in case this Act had not been made.

VII. And he it further enacted, That this Act shall be printed by the Evidence. several Printers to the King's most Excellent Majesty, duly authorized to print the Statutes of the United Kingdom, and a Copy thereof so printed by any of them, shall be admitted as Evidence thereof by all Judges, Justices, and others.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

The Advowson of the Rectory of Depding otherwise Depden in the County of Suffolk and Diocese of Norwich; the Great and Small Tythes whereof, with the Rectory House, Barn, Stable, and Glebe Lands, are worth the yearly Sum of Four hundred Pounds.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

The Advowson of the Rectory of South Cove in the County of Suffolk and Diocese of Norwich; the Great and Small Tythes whereof, with the Glebe Lands, are worth the yearly Sum of Two hundred and ninety Pounds.
