An Act for the Improvement of the Shannon Navigation, from the City of Limerick to Killaloe, by rebuilding the Bridge called Baal's Bridge, [17th June 1830.] in the said City.

THEREAS by an Act passed in Ireland in the Second Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the First, intituled An Act to encourage the draining and improving 2 G. 1. (I.) the Bogs and unprofitable low Grounds in Ireland, and for easing and dispatching the Inland Carriage and Conveyance of Goods from one Part to another within this Kingdom, it is enacted, amongst other things, that certain Persons therein named, their Heirs and Assigns, should be and were thereby authorized and empowered, at their proper Costs and Charges, to make the River Shannon navigable, portable, and passable for Boats, Lighters, and other Vessels of Burden to navigate and pass therein, and by and through the same, from the new Quay, Wharf, and common Landing Place of the City of Limerick to the Town of Carrickdrum Rush in the County of Leitrim, through and by the Counties of Limerick, Clare, Galway, and Tipperary, King's County, Westmeath, Longford, Roscommon, and Leitrim, and from Time to Time to continue, maintain, exercise, and use such Navigation at his and their Will and Pleasure: And whereas by an Act passed in Ireland in the Thirty-first Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, intituled An 31G.2. (I.) Act for the widening and repairing or rebuilding a Bridge called [Local.] Baal's

Baal's Bridge, in the City and Garrison of Limerick, and for enabling and obliging the Person entitled to the Houses and Ground on the said Bridge to dispose of their Interests in the same, on reasonable Terms, 33 G.2. (I.) for the Purposes aforesaid, and an Amendment thereof passed in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of the said King George the Second, certain Persons therein named were constituted and appointed Commissioners for repairing the said Bridge, but for Want of Funds they were unable to take down or rebuild the same: And whereas the Wharf or common Landing Place of the said City of Limerick lie at the North-west or Sea Side of Baal's Bridge in the said City: And whereas certain Merchants and others residing in and about the City of Limerick undertook the forming the Canal which runs from the deep Water above the Town of Killaloe to Limerick, and accordingly proceeded to make the same from Killaloe to the South-east Side of said Bridge called Baal's Bridge: And whereas by another Act passed in the Parliament of Ireland in the Seventh Year of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled 7 G. 3. (I.) An Act for applying the Sum of Six thousand Pounds granted by Parliament to the Corporation for promoting and carrying on an Inland Navigation in this Kingdom, to be by them applied in carrying on a Navigation from the City of Limerick to the deep navigable Water above the Town of Killaloe, and for encouraging other Persons to subscribe for carrying on and completing the said Work at their own Expence, it was enacted that certain Persons subscribing Money as therein mentioned for completing the said Navigation were incorporated by the Name of "The Company of Undertakers for making the River Shannon navigable from Limerick to Killaloe," with full Powers. as therein mentioned: And whereas by an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom in the Fifty-third Year of His said late Majesty, 53G.3. c.144. intituled An Act to amend an Act of the Parliament of Ireland of the Fortieth Year of His present Majesty, for promoting Inland Navigation in Ireland, Provision was made for purchasing the Interest of the then Limerick Navigation Company in the Navigation and Works then vested in and belonging to the said Company, and for transferring, conveying, and vesting all Right and Interest of the said Company on

the said Navigation in the Directors General of Inland Navigation: And whereas the River Shannon hath not been made navigable or passable for Boats, Barges, Lighters, or other Vessels of Burden to navigate and pass therein, and by and through the same, from the new Quay, Wharf, and common Landing Place of the City of Limerick to the Town of Carrickdrum Rush in the County of Leitrim; and the Navigation and Commerce of the said Canal, and the Trade of the said City of Limerick, have been greatly impeded and injured by the Stoppage and Impediment to the said Navigation in consequence of the said Bridge called Baal's Bridge, through or under which no Canal Boat can pass with Safety, and it being therefore requisite for all such Boats as come up to the said Bridge to discharge their Cargoes at one Side thereof, for the Purpose of being conveyed by Land for Reshipment at the other Side of the said Bridge, to the Risk of Injury to the Cargoes thus transhipped, and great Loss and Inconvenience to the Public: And whereas the Inhabitants of the Counties of Clare and Limerick repeatedly applied to the said Board of Inland Navigation to have the said Bridge rebuilt and made passable

able for Vessels; and the said Board having caused their Engineer to examine the said Bridge, he reported that the same was a Nuisance, injurious to the Public, and a complete Interruption to the Navigation of the Shannon, and that the rebuilding of the same would be attended with great Advantage to the Trade of the Counties of Clare and Limerick, and would extend the Navigation above Eighty Miles on the Shannon, and make a direct Communication through the said Canal between the Counties of Limerick, Clare, and Kerry, and the Western Parts of Great Britain, thus facilitating the Transmission of Irish Produce, and the Returns of Colonial and manufactured Goods, and thereby completing the Navigation as intended by the said recited Acts; but the said Board of Inland Navigation were unable to rebuild the same, from having no Funds at their Disposal: And whereas it is just and expedient that the Property of the said Canal and Navigation, from the deep Water above Killaloe to Limerick, with the Tolls and Profits thereof, should be applied to the Purposes of rebuilding and maintaining the said Bridge, and extending or otherwise improving the Navigation of the said River Shannon, and that the same should be vested in a Company of Persons interested in the Maintenance and Preservation of the same, and who would undertake the Superintendence and Management of the said Canal, and the Outlay of such Sum or Sums of Money as might be deemed necessary for the general Improvement of the said Navigation of the River Shannon, within such Period, in such Manner, and under such Controul as the Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors of Ireland for the Time being shall direct and appoint: And whereas several Persons have entered into a Subscription for the Purpose of raising a Joint Stock or Fund for the Purposes aforesaid, and have formed themselves into a Company under the Denomination of "The Limerick Navigation Company:" And whereas the said Limerick Navigation Company have proposed to undertake the Superintendence and Outlay of such Sum or Sums of Money as shall be necessary for the rebuilding of the said Bridge, and for the general Improvement of the said River, in manner to be approved of by an Engineer for that Purpose appointed by the Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors of Ireland for the Time being, and to complete the same in Two Years from the passing of this Act: And whereas it is expedient that the said Company should be formed into a Corporate Body, and the said Navigation of the Shannon from Killaloe to Limerick, with the Tolls and Profits thereof, be vested in such Corporate Body, to enable them to make the proposed Improvements in the said Navigation, and to maintain the same in good and sufficient Order, under such Restrictions and Regulations as Parliament shall deem fit and expedient: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That Power of whenever and so soon as it shall be made appear, upon any Plan and Commis-Estimate, to the Satisfaction of the Lord Lieutenant or other Chief sioners of Governor or Covernor or Governor or Governors, what Sum shall be necessary and sufficient Navigation for the rebuilding of the said Bridge, and Improvement of the said to cease. Navigation, and that the same has been actually subscribed, and

the Payment thereof fully made or secured, it shall be lawful for such Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors, by any Order to be signified to the said Limerick Navigation Company by the Chief Secretary of such Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors, to declare the Approbation of such Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors of such Plan and Estimate, and to direct that from a Day to be mentioned in such Order all Powers and Authorities whatsoever vested in the said Directors General of Inland Navigation, or in any Commissioners, Officers, Servants, Agents, or other Persons employed, appointed, or authorized by them, shall cease and determine, and shall become null and void, so far as the same relate to the Navigation of the said River Shannon from the deep navigable Water above the Town of Killaloe to Limerick, or of any Part thereof, or of the Property, Tolls, or Profits of the same, or to the Controul, Management, or conducting thereof, and all such Powers and Authorities shall thereupon actually cease and determine accordingly, and shall be and become and are hereby declared to be null and void.

Limerick and Killaloe Navigation Company to to be a Corporation.

II. And be it further enacted, That from and after the Day mentioned in such Order of the Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors of Ireland, the Mayor of the City of Limerick, the President and Vice President of the Chamber of Commerce of Limerick, the Chairman of the Limerick Bridge Commissioners, all for the Time being, and the several Person or Persons who have so as aforesaid formed themselves into a Company for managing, directing, extending, improving, repairing, and governing the said Navigation, or such of them as shall from Time to Time be possessed of any Share or Shares in the said Undertaking, with such other Person or Persons, Bodies Politic or Corporate, as may hereafter from Time to Time be possessed of any Shares therein, their Successors and Assigns, shall be a Corporation by the Name of "The Limerick Navigation Company;" and that the said Corporation shall have perpetual Succession and a Common Seal, and shall be capable in Law to purchase and take Messuages, Lands, Tenements, and Hereditaments, for the Purposes of this Act, without incurring any of the Penalties and Forfeitures of the Statutes of Mortmain.

Property vested in the Corporation.

III. And be it further enacted, That from and after the Day mentioned in such Order of the Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors of Ireland, the entire of the said Shannon Navigation, extending from deep Water above the Town of Killaloe to the Port of the City of Limerick, with the Trackways, Weirs, Lands, Houses, Yards, Locks, Stores, Punts, Barges, Implements, Rights, Ways, and Property whatsoever thereunto belonging or appertaining, also all Maps, Estimates, Plans, and other Documents belonging or appertaining to the said Navigation, and requisite and necessary for the Purposes of this Act, shall be and the same are hereby vested in the said Corporation of the Limerick Navigation Company, and with the like Powers for the said Company, their Officers and Servants, of levying Tolls, Rates, and Duties, making Bye Laws, and regulating the Navigation, and maintaining, repairing, deepening, extending, and improving the same, and all other Powers vested in the Direc-

tors General of Inland Navigation, by the said recited Acts, and also the Acts relating to Baal's Bridge, or in the Commissioners appointed by the said recited Acts for the Improvement of the said Bridge called Baal's Bridge, or the Corporation so created by the said recited Act passed in the Seventh Year of His said Majesty King George the Third, for carrying the Inland Navigation from the City of Limerick to the deep Water above the Town of Killaloe.

IV. And be it further enacted, That the said Directors General of Directors of Inland Navigation shall, upon Demand and Production of such Order Inland Naviof the Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors of gation to Ireland, signified as aforesaid, deliver up to the said Limerick Naviga- Property, tion Company the Possession of all such Trackways, Weirs, Lands, Books, &c. Houses, Yards, Locks, Stores, Punts, Barges, Implements, Rights, relating to Ways, and Property thereunto belonging or appertaining whatsoever, Navigation. and also of all such Books, Papers, Accounts, Maps, Plans, Estimates, Surveys, and other Documents, Matters, and Things relating to the said Shannon Navigation, at Limerick and Killaloe as aforesaid, now in their Possession or Custody, or in the Possession of any Commissioner, Surveyor, Officer, or Person or Persons in Trust for them or any of them, as the Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors of Ireland shall think requisite and necessary for the Purposes of this Act, and as shall be specified and required in and by any Order, Direction, or Notice to be signified and communicated to the said Directors of Inland Navigation at any Time by the Chief Secretary of such Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors of *Ireland*.

V. And whereas, by the said recited Act of the Fortieth Year of Company not the Reign of King George the Third, Power is given to the said Directors General of Inland Navigation to charge and levy certain &c. than are Tonnage Rates and Tolls on the said Canal, as therein mentioned; already be it further enacted, That it shall not be lawful to demand or charged. receive any higher Tonnage Rates or Tolls on the said Canal than are fixed, taken, and charged by the said Directors General of Inland Navigation, on the said Canal, at the Time of the passing of this Act.

VI. And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for Company the said Company, and they are hereby authorized, by themselves, empower to build their Deputies, Agents, Officers, Contractors, Workmen, and Servants, Bridge. to take down said Bridge called Baal's Bridge, and to remove and take away the Materials of same, with all Buildings now standing or remaining thereon, and to design, lay out, make, erect, and build one Bridge of Stone or Iron over the said River Shannon, at or near the Scite where the said Bridge called Baal's Bridge now stands, and agreeably to the Plans deposited with the Clerk of the Parliament, and to make convenient Roads and Approaches thereto, and to open a free Navigation of the said River Shannon from Killaloe outwards to the Mouth of the said River; and it shall be lawful to and for the said Company, and their Successors, to design, assign, lay out, and appoint in what Manner and of what Dimensions such Bridge shall be built, and from Time to Time to design, assign, and lay out such [Local.]37 B Streets,

empowered

Streets, Roads, and Approaches to the said Bridge, and upon such Plans and of such Dimensions respectively, as the said Company shall think proper.

Houses not to be taken down without Consent, or Compensation being made.

VII. Provided always, and be it further enacted, That nothing in this Act contained shall authorize or be held to authorize the said Limerick Navigation Company to remove or take down the Houses on the said Bridge, without the Consent of the Persons interested therein, or until Compensation be made to such Person or Persons pursuant to the Provisions of the said herein-before recited Act of the Thirty-third George the Second, Chapter Fifteen.

Limitation of Time.

VIII. And be it further enacted, That the rebuilding of the said Bridge shall be commenced within Three Months, and be completed within Two Years, from the passing of this Act.

The Whole to be subscribed before the Act is put in force.

IX. And whereas the probable Expence of building the said of the Capital Bridge and other Works hereby authorized to be made will amount to the Sum of Three thousand Pounds, and the Sum of Two thousand five hundred Pounds, being more than Four Fifth Parts thereof, has already been subscribed by several Persons under a Contract binding themselves, their Heirs, Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, for Payment of the several Sums by them subscribed respectively; be it further enacted, That the whole of the said Sum of Three thousand Pounds shall be subscribed before any of the Powers given by this Act shall be put in force.

Company empowered to raise the Money amongst themselves.

X. And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the said Limerick Navigation Company to raise and contribute amongst themselves, in such Proportions as to them shall seem meet and convenient, such Sum or Sums of Money as shall be necessary for making, carrying on, and completing the said Bridge and Works hereby authorized to be made, not less than the whole Sum of Three thousand Pounds, and that the same shall be divided into such Numbers of Parts or Shares as herein-after directed; and the Money so subscribed and to be raised as aforesaid, or a sufficient Part thereof, shall be laid out and applied, in the first place, in payment, satisfaction and discharge of the Costs, Charges, and Expences attending the obtaining and passing of this Act, and the making of the proper Surveys, Plans and Estimates, and for the doing and providing of all the Matters and Things preparatory and previous thereto; and all the Residue of such Money, or so much thereof as shall be necessary, shall be applied and disposed of for or towards the making, carrying, and completing and maintaining of the said Navigation, and other Works respectively, and for other the Purposes of this Act.

The Stock to be divided into Shares.

XI. And be it further enacted, That the said Sum of Three thousand Pounds so to be subscribed as aforesaid shall be divided into Sixty equal Shares, and that no Person shall take or subscribe for less than One Share in the said Undertaking and such Share shall be numbered in regular numerical Progression, and every Share shall for ever afterwards be distinguished by the Number to be appointed for the same; and the said Sixty Shares shall be and they are hereby

vested in the several Persons, Bodies Politic and Corporate, subscribing for and undertaking to raise and contribute the same, and their respective Executors, Administrators, Successors, and Assigns, to and for their own respective Use and Benefit, according and proportionably to the Number of Shares which they shall respectively subscribe for and undertake to raise and contribute; and all Persons, Bodies Politic and Corporate, and their respective Executors, Administrators, Successors, and Assigns, who shall subscribe for any Share or Shares in the said Undertaking, and pay such Sum or Sums of Money as shall be demanded on account thereof, towards the rebuilding of the said Bridge and other Works hereby authorized to be made, shall be entitled to and receive, after the said Work shall be completed, a due and just Proportion, according to their respective Number of Shares, of the clear Profits and Advantages which shall or may arise or accrue by or from the Rates, Tolls, Duties, and other Monies to be raised, recovered, or received by virtue of this Act as herein-after mentioned, according to the true Intent and Meaning hereof.

XII. And be it enacted, That at every General or other Meeting As to voting of said Company every Question shall be decided by all on the at General Majority in Number and Value (according to their respective Shares Meetings. of the said Capital as directed by this Act) of the Proprietors present and qualified to vote; provided that no Person shall be entitled to vote at any such Meeting unless he or she shall have been a bond fide Holder of not less than Two Shares of Fifty Pounds each in the Capital of said Company for Six Months at least; and at every General Meeting a Chairman shall be appointed by the Proprietors present; and every Chairman shall be entitled to his Vote or Votes as a Proprietor, and also, in case of Equality of Votes, shall have the casting Vote: Provided always, that at all special and other Meetings of the said Company the Persons herein-before specially named as Directors ex officio shall be and they hereby are authorized to vote without the Qualification herein set forth.

XIII. And for the better enforcing the Payment of the said Sums Enforcing so subscribed, be it further enacted, That if any Person or Persons Payment of upon whom any Call or Calls for Money shall or may hereafter be Subscription. made under or by virtue of this Act, for or in respect of any Share or Shares in the said Undertaking, shall neglect or refuse to pay his, her, or their rateable or proportionable Share or Shares of the said Money to be called for and raised by virtue of this Act, for the Space of Twenty-one Days next ensuing any such Call, he, she, or they so neglecting or refusing shall forfeit and pay the Sum of Twenty Pounds for every Share he, she, or they shall have in the said Undertaking; and if such Person or Persons shall continue to neglect or refuse to pay his, her, or their rateable or proportionable Share or Shares of the said Money to be called for and raised as aforesaid, for the Space of Three Calendar Months next after such Call or Calls shall have been appointed to be paid as aforesaid, then and in such Case it shall and may be lawful to and for the said Limerick Navigation Company, at some General or Special General Meeting to be held after such Neglect or Refusal, to declare all and every or any of the Share

Share or Sharesof such Person or Persons so neglecting or refusing as aforesaid to be disposed of for the Purposes of this Act: Provided always, that no Share or Shares of and in the said Undertaking shall be forfeited or vested in or shall accrue to the said Limerick Navigation Company until Notice thereof in Writing shall be given by the Clerk of the said Company to the Person or Persons, or to the Clerk or Clerks or other Head Officer or Officers of the Body or Bodies Politic, Corporate, or Collegiate, in whose Name or Names such Share or Shares shall at the Time of giving such Notice stand registered in the Books of the said Company, or left at his, her, or their Dwelling House or usual or last known Place of Abode, Ten Days at least previous to such Share or Shares vesting in or accruing to the said Limerick Navigation Company, provided that such Place or Places of Abode shall be known to the Clerk of the said Navigation Company; and in case the same shall be unknown to the Clerk of the said Company, such Notice shall be published in the Dublin Gazette, and such other public Newspaper or Newspapers as the said Committee shall order and direct; in which Notices respectively shall be contained a Statement and Account of how much Money is due from such Person or Persons, Body or Bodies Politic, Corporate, or Collegiate, for his, her, or their Share or Shares in the said Undertaking; and that no such Share or Shares shall be forfeited to or vested in the said Limerick Navigation Company if the Owner or Owners of such Share or Shares shall pay what shall appear by such Statement to be due, together with legal Interest on the same, and the aforesaid Penalties for Nonpayment, and all Expences attending the Application for the same, within the Time specified in such Notice; any thing contained in this Act to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding.

The Corporation may buy up Shares.

XIV. And be it further enacted, That if the Limerick Navigation Company, or their Committee of Management for the Time being, shall deem it expedient, out of any Surplus of Monies, or otherwise, to take up any Share or Shares in the said Canal Navigation which shall be offered for Sale, then and in such Case it shall be lawful for any General Meeting of the said Limerick Navigation Company, either to direct that any such Share or Shares so bought shall merge in the said Undertaking, or that the same shall be transferred to the Clerk of the said Limerick Navigation Company in Trust for the said Company; and such Share or Shares may in such last-mentioned Case, at any Time thereafter, be sold for the Benefit of the said Company, and for the raising of any Sum of Money which may be wanted for or towards the erecting or repairing of any Building or Works belonging to the said Canal, or any other Purpose necessary for carrying on the same.

XV. And be it further enacted, That all and every Person and Persons, Body and Bodies Politic, Corporate, or Collegiate, and their respective Executors, Administrators, Successors, and Assigns, who shall by virtue of this Act have subscribed or undertaken for, or become entitled to and be in the actual Possession of, Two Shares for or towards raising the Sum of Three thousand Pounds, hereby authorized to be raised in the first instance, shall have a Vote or Votes at

all Meetings of the said Navigation Company to be held in pursuance of this Act, for or in respect of the Shares for, to, or of which he, she, or they shall have so subscribed, undertaken, or become entitled or possessed, in manner following; (that is to say,) for or in respect of One Vote for Two Shares, Two Votes for Five Shares, and Three Votes for Ten or more Shares; and every Question, Matter, or Thing which shall be proposed, discussed, or considered at any Meeting of the said Company to be held in pursuance of this Act, shall be determined by the Majority of Votes then present.

XVI. Provided always, and be it further enacted, That it shall Proprietors and may be lawful for every such Body Politic, Corporate, or Collegiate may vote by entitled to vote at Meetings of the said Limerick Navigation Company to be held in pursuance of this Act, by Writing under their Common or Corporate Seal, and also for all and every other Person and Persons entitled to vote as aforesaid, by Writing under his, her, or their Hand or Hands, and in case of the Infancy, Idiotcy, or Lunacy of any such Person or Persons, then for his, her, or their Guardian or Guardians, Committee or Committees, by Writing under the Hand or Hands of each Guardian or Guardians, Committee or Committees, to constitute and appoint any other Proprietor or Proprietors entitled to vote in respect of his, her, or their own Share or Shares in the said Undertaking, their, his, or her Proxy or Proxies, to vote at any such Meeting of the said Limerick Navigation Company; and every such Vote by Proxy shall be as good and valid, to all Intents and Purposes, as if the Principal or Principals had voted in Person.

XVII. And be it further enacted, That the Appointment of every Form of Proxy to vote under and by virtue of this Act shall and may be made Proxy. in the Form or to the Effect following; that is to say,
