An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Minister of Health relating to Chiswick Dartford Denton Orsett (Rural) Rochdale Rotherham (Rural) Southport the Thurrock Grays and Tilbury Joint Sewerage District and the County Palatine of Lancaster. A.D. 1920.
[4th August 1920.]

WHEREAS the Minister of Health has made the Provisional Orders set forth in the First Schedule hereto under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 and the Provisional Order set forth in the Second Schedule hereto under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 and the Local Government Act 1888: 38 & 39 Vict.
