WHEREAS the Minister of Health has made the Provisional Orders set forth in the First Schedule hereto under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 and the 38 & 39 Vict. Provisional Order set forth in the Second Schedule hereto under c. 55. The provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 and the Local c. 41. Government Act 1888:
