CHAPTER xxxii.

An Act to confirm a Scheme of the Charity Commissioners for the application or management of the Charity known as the Fuel Allotment in the Ancient Parishes of Feltwell St. Mary and Feltwell St. Nicholas in the County of Norfolk.

[29th July 1927.]

WHEREAS the Charity Commissioners in their report to His Majesty of their proceedings during the year One thousand nine hundred and twenty-six reported that they had approved and certified a Scheme for the application or management of the charity known as the Fuel Allotment in the ancient parishes of Feltwell St. Mary and Feltwell St. Nicholas in the County of Norfolk comprised in an award dated the Eighth day of September One thousand eight hundred and fifteen made under the Inclosure Act 53 Geo. III cap. CXLII:

And whereas it is expedient that the Scheme as the same is fully set out and defined in the Schedule to this Act should be confirmed:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present

- A.D. 1927. Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

Confirmation of Scheme. 1. The said Scheme is hereby confirmed Provided always that nothing in this Act or in the said Scheme shall be held to interfere with the ordinary jurisdiction over endowed charities now exerciseable or hereafter to become exerciseable by the High Court of Justice and the Charity Commissioners.

Short title.

2. This Act may be cited as the Feltwell Fuel Allotment Charity Scheme Confirmation Act 1927.

SCHEDULE.

A.D. 1927.

- Scheme for the Application or Management of the Charity known as the Fuel Allotment in the Ancient Parishes of Feltwell St. Mary and Feltwell St. Nicholas in the County of Norfolk comprised in an Award dated the Eighth day of September One thousand eight hundred and fifteen made under the Inclosure Act 53 Geo. III Cap. CXLII.
- 1. The Trustees of the above-mentioned charity may under the authority of an order or orders of the Charity Commissioners sell the whole or any part of the hereditaments specified in the schedule hereto and belonging to the charity.
- 2. The Trustees shall apply a sufficient part of the net proceeds of any such sale in discharging the debt owing at the date of this Scheme by the charity to the Feltwell Fen Second District Commissioners in respect of drainage tax.
- 3. The balance of the said net proceeds of sale after payment of the said debt shall be remitted by the Trustees to the banking account at the Bank of England of "the Official Trustees of Charitable Funds" and shall be invested by the said Official Trustees in their name in trust for the charity in one or more of the stocks funds or securities (other than real securities) authorised by law for the investment of trust funds.
- 4. The sum required to discharge the said debt shall be replaced within a period not exceeding thirty years out of the income of the charity in such manner as shall be directed by an Order of the Charity Commissioners.
- 5. All charges and outgoings payable in respect of the property of the charity and all the proper costs charges and expenses of and incidental to the administration and management of the charity and any yearly or other sum required for replacing the sum applied in discharging the said debt shall be first defrayed by the Trustees out of the income of the charity.
- 6. Subject to the payments aforesaid the yearly income of the charity shall be laid out in the purchase of fuel and such

- A.D. 1927. fuel shall be distributed among such poor inhabitants of the ancient parishes of Feltwell St. Mary and Feltwell St. Nicholas as shall not occupy lands or tenements of more than the yearly value of ten pounds and as shall be legally settled therein and such fuel shall be delivered at their respective dwelling-houses there in such proportions and quantities in such manner and at such times in every year and according to such rules and orders as the Trustees shall appoint and prescribe for that purpose.
 - 7. The Charity Commissioners may from time to time in the exercise of their ordinary jurisdiction establish Schemes for the alteration of any of the provisions of this Scheme as if those provisions had been made by the founder in the case of a charity having a founder.
 - 8. Any question as to the construction of this Scheme or as to the regularity or the validity of any acts done or about to be done under this Scheme shall be determined conclusively by the Charity Commissioners upon such application made to them for the purpose as they think sufficient.
 - 9. The date of this Scheme shall be the date of the Act of Parliament confirming the same.
