CHAPTER xlvi.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the A.D. 1935.

Minister of Health relating to the borough of
Guildford.

[10th July 1935.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health 38 & 39 Vict. Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made a c. 55. provisional order which needs confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 1. The order of the Minister of Health which as Order in amended is set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby schedule confirmed and shall have full validity and force.
- 2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Short title. Provisional Order Confirmation (Guildford) Act 1935.

Guildford Order.

BOROUGH OF GUILDFORD.

Provisional Order for altering a Local Act.

WHEREAS the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the borough of Guildford (hereinafter referred to as "the borough") acting by the Council (in this order called "the Corporation") are the local authority for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875;

And whereas there are in force in the borough the unrepealed provisions of the Guildford Corporation Act 1886 as amended by the Guildford (Extension) Order 1904 the Guildford (Extension) Order 1922 and the Guildford Order 1928 (which Orders were duly confirmed by Parliament) the Guildford Corporation Act 1926 and the Surrey Review Order 1933 (which Acts and Orders are hereinafter referred to as the Acts and Orders of the years in which they were respectively passed or made);

And whereas the Corporation carry on a water undertaking under the said Acts and Orders and Section 33 of the Act of 1886 as amended by Article 11 of the Order of 1904 Article 13 of the Order of 1922 Article 1 of the Order of 1928 and Section 116 of the Order of 1933 defines the limits within which the Corporation may supply water;

And whereas the Corporation have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order further to amend the Act of 1886 in the manner hereinafter set forth:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders that from the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order the Act of 1886 shall be further amended as follows:—

Extension of water limits of Corporation.

1. The limits of the Corporation for the supply of water shall be extended so as to include so much of the borough as was immediately prior to the appointed day within the meaning of the Order of 1933 comprised within the rural district of

Guildford and the provisions of any Act or Order with respect to the supply of water and otherwise with respect to water purposes which now apply and have effect within the existing limits of the Corporation for the supply of water shall (with any necessary modifications) apply and have effect within the limits of the Corporation for the supply of water as extended by this Order.
