

## CHAPTER cxxix.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the A.D. 1913.

Local Government Board relating to Brynmawr Cambridge Chiswick Croydon Doncaster Nelson Rhondda Willesden and Wood Green. [15th August 1913.]

WHEREAS the Local Government Board have made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875:
