CHAPTER xxv.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the A.D. 1936.

Minister of Health relating to the Bridport

Joint Hospital District. [21st May 1936.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public 38 & 39 Health Act 1875 the Minister of Health has Vict. c. 55. made a Provisional Order which needs confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 1. The order of the Minister of Health which as Order in amended is set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby schedule confirmed and shall have full validity and force.
- 2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Short title. Provisional Order Confirmation (Bridport Joint Hospital District) Act 1936.

BRIDPORT JOINT HOSPITAL DISTRICT.

Provisional Order altering the Bridgert Joint Hospital Order 1917.

WHEREAS by virtue of the Bridport Joint Hospital Order 1917 which was confirmed by Parliament as amended by the Bridport Joint Hospital Amendment Order 1935 (in this order called "the order of 1935") the boroughs of Bridport and Lyme Regis and the rural district of Beaminster constitute a united district called the Bridport joint hospital district for the provision of hospitals for infectious diseases and the governing body of the united district is the Bridport joint hospital board;

And whereas application has been made to the Minister of Health to include in the united district the rural district of Bridport:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 297 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

Short titles and commencement.

- 1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Bridport Joint Hospital Order 1936 and this order the order of 1935 and the Bridport Joint Hospital Order 1917 may be cited together as the Bridport Joint Hospital Orders 1917 to 1936.
- (2) This order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

Interpretation.

- 2. In this order unless the context otherwise requires—
 - "the appointed day" means the first day of October nineteen hundred and thirty-six;
 - "the joint board" means the Bridport joint hospital board;
 - "the order of 1917" means the Bridport Joint Hospital Order 1917 which was confirmed by the Local Government Board's Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 3) Act 1917;

> "the united district" means the Bridport joint hospital district; and

"the rural district" means the rural district of Bridport and "the rural council" means the council of that district.

Bridport Order.

- 3. As from the appointed day—
 - (i) the united district shall be extended so as to include the rural district;

Extension of united district and future constitution of joint board.

- (ii) the joint board shall consist of four ex-officio members and ten elective members; and
- (iii) the schedule to this order shall be substituted for the schedule to the order of 1917 and that order (as amended by the order of 1935) shall have effect accordingly.
- 4. The provisions of article XI of the order of 1917 shall apply to the first election by the rural council of the elective members to represent them on the joint board as if the election related to the filling of vacancies occurring on the appointed day.

Election of elective members by rural council.

5. For paragraph (2) of article XIX of the order of 1917 Expenses of there shall be substituted the following provision:—

joint board.

(2) To the common fund so far as the same is not provided by the aforesaid payments the constituent authorities respectively shall contribute in the following proportions (namely) :--

> By the Bridport council - Two-sevenths.

By the Lyme Regis council -- One-seventh.

- Two-sevenths. By the Beaminster council -

By the rural council -- Two-sevenths.

6. All property immediately before the appointed day Property and vested in the joint board for the benefit of the united district shall by virtue of this order be held by the joint board for the benefit of the united district as extended by this order and all liabilities which immediately before the appointed day attach to the joint board shall attach to them in respect of the united district as extended by this order.

liabilities of joint board.

7. Article XXIII of the order of 1917 which relates to the Application adaptation of that order on an alteration being made in the area of a constituent district and article XXIV of the order of 1917 which relates to the settlement by arbitration of differences 1917. arising out of that order shall have effect as if the reference in those articles to the order of 1917 included a reference to this order.
