CHAPTER xxxiv.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Minister of Health relating to the city of Bristol. A.D. 1936.
[29th May 1936.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made a Provisional Order which needs confirmation by Parliament : 38 & 39 Vict. c. 55.

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The order of the Minister of Health which is set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed and shall have full validity and force. Order in schedule confirmed.

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Order Confirmation (Bristol) Act 1936. Short title.

CITY OF BRISTOL.

Provisional order altering a local Act.

WHEREAS the city of Bristol is an urban district of which the lord mayor aldermen and burgesses acting by the council (in this order called "the corporation") are the local authority for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875 and there is in force in the city the Clifton and Durdham Downs (Bristol) Act 1861 (in this order called "the Act of 1861");

And whereas by section 10 of the Act of 1861 a committee called the Downs Committee was constituted for the management of the Clifton and Durdham Downs and by section 11 of the said Act as amended by section 67 of the Bristol Corporation Act 1904 and section 183 of the Bristol Corporation Act 1926 the corporation were authorised to expend in any one year for the purposes of the Act of 1861 any sum not exceeding one thousand pounds;

And whereas the corporation have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a provisional order to alter or amend the Act of 1861 in the manner following:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Bristol Order 1936 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Increase of
expenditure

2. Notwithstanding anything in section 11 of the Act of 1861 as amended by section 67 of the Bristol Corporation Act 1904 and section 183 of the Bristol Corporation Act 1926 the corporation if they think fit may pay to the Downs Committee in any one year in addition to the sum mentioned in the said Act of 1926 any sum or sums not exceeding one thousand pounds and any additional sum or sums so paid shall be applied by the Downs Committee in carrying the said Act of 1861 into execution.
