CHAPTER xxxvi.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the A.D. 1936.

Minister of Health relating to the borough of Stockton-on-Tees.

[29th May 1936.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public 38 & 39 Health Act 1875 the Minister of Health has Vict. c. 55. made a Provisional Order which needs confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 1. The order of the Minister of Health which is Order in set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed schedule and shall have full validity and force.
- 2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Short title. Provisional Order Confirmation (Stockton-on-Tees) Act 1936.

Stockton-on-Tees Order.

BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES.

Provisional Order altering a local Act.

WHEREAS the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the borough of Stockton-on-Tees acting by the council (in this order called "the corporation") are the local authority for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875 and the Stockton-on-Tees Corporation (Works) Act 1930 (in this order called "the local Act") as amended by the Stockton-on-Tees Order 1933 which was confirmed

by Parliament is in force in the borough;

And whereas by section 5 of the local Act the corporation are authorised to enter on take and use certain lands shown on the deposited plans and described in the deposited book of reference for the purpose of constructing the works mentioned in section 21 of the local Act and by section 6 of that Act as amended by the Stockton-on-Tees Order 1933 in so far as it relates to Works Nos. 7 to 10 mentioned in section 21 of the local Act a period of six years from the first day of October nineteen hundred and thirty was limited for the exercise of the powers of the corporation for the compulsory purchase of lands;

And whereas the corporation have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a provisional order further to amend

the local Act in the manner following:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

Short title and commencement.

1. This order may be cited as the Stockton-on-Tees Order 1936 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Interpretation.

In this order the expression—
 "Works Nos. 7 to 10" means Work No. 7 Work No. 8
 Work No. 9 and Work No. 10 mentioned in section 21 of the local Act.

Extension of time for compulsory purchase of lands. 3. Section 6 of the local Act amended as aforesaid in so far as it relates to Works Nos. 7 to 10 shall have effect as if the words "nine years" were inserted therein instead of the words "six years."
