



CHAPTER xc.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Minister of Health relating to the city of Leeds. A.D. 1936.
[31st July 1936.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made a provisional order which needs confirmation by Parliament :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The order of the Minister of Health which is set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed and shall have full validity and force.

*Provisional order amending the Leeds Corporation
(Consolidation) Act 1905.*

WHEREAS the lord mayor aldermen and citizens of the city of Leeds acting by the council (in this order called "the corporation") in pursuance of the Leeds Corporation (Consolidation) Act 1905 as amended by the Leeds (Rating &c.) Order 1915 (which was confirmed by Parliament) and the Leeds Corporation Act 1927 (in this order called "the local Act") carry on a water undertaking and supply water within certain limits and levy water rates rents and charges for the supply of water;

And whereas the corporation have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue under the Public Health Act 1875 of a provisional order to amend the local Act in the manner following:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders that from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this order the local Act shall be altered or amended so that the following provision shall take effect (that is to say):—

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 70 of the Waterworks Clauses Act 1847 the corporation may from time to time by resolution determine the dates on which all or any of the water rates rents or charges which they are by this or any other Act or order relating to their water undertaking authorised to demand and take shall be payable in advance by equal quarterly payments.

Short title.

2. This order may be cited as the Leeds Order 1936.
