CHAPTER xcix.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Minister of Health relating to the city of Ripon. A.D. 1936.
[31st July 1936.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made a provisional order which needs confirmation by Parliament: 38 & 39 Vict. c. 55.

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The order of the Minister of Health which as amended is set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed and shall have full validity and force. Order in schedule confirmed.

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Order Confirmation (Ripon) Act 1936. Short title.

Ripon Order.

CITY OF RIPON.

Provisional order partially altering a local Act and repealing certain confirming Acts and orders.

WHEREAS the mayor aldermen and citizens of the city of Ripon (in this order called "the city") acting by the council (in this order called "the corporation") are the local authority for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875 and there are in force in the city the unrepealed provisions of the Ripon Corporation Act 1886 (in this order called "the local Act") as altered by the Ripon Order 1899 and the Ripon Order 1921 which were duly confirmed by Parliament;

And whereas by section 42 of the local Act as altered by the Ripon Order 1921 the corporation are empowered to demand and take the tolls stallages and rents in respect of their markets and fairs not exceeding the tolls stallages and rents specified in the schedule to the local Act as altered as aforesaid;

And whereas the corporation have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a provisional order partially to alter the local Act and to repeal the orders aforesaid in the manner following :

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows :—

Short title
and com-
mencement.

1. This order may be cited as the Ripon Order 1936 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Alteration of
tolls &c. in
respect of
markets and
fairs.

2.—(1) The local Act as altered by the Ripon Order 1921 shall be further altered by the substitution for the tolls stallages and rents specified in the schedule thereto of the tolls stallages and rents specified in the first schedule to this order.

(2) The corporation may with the sanction of the Minister of Health from time to time alter or add to the tolls stallages and rents authorised by the local Act as further altered by this order and any such altered tolls stallages and rents shall as from the date on which they come into operation be substituted for the corresponding tolls stallages and rents payable as aforesaid :

Provided that notice of the intention of the corporation to apply to the Minister of Health for his sanction to any alteration of or addition to the tolls stallages or rents with respect to fairs and feasts shall be published in the London Gazette. A.D. 1936.

3. The confirming Acts set out in column 2 of the second schedule to this order so far as those Acts respectively relate to the unrepealed portions of the orders set out in column 3 of the said schedule are hereby repealed without prejudice to any act or thing already done thereunder. Repeals.

The above-mentioned tolls stallages and rents are to be payable as well by the original hirer or user of any stall standing place or space for a portion of the day in case he shall not occupy the same for the whole day as also by any subsequent hirer or user of the same for the residue or any other portion of the same day.
