CHAPTER xxxi.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Minister of Health relating to the city of Sheffield.

[30th July 1948.]

TWHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health 38 & 39 Vict. Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made a Provisional c. 55. Order which needs confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 1. The Order of the Minister of Health which is set out in Order in the schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed and shall have full schedule confirmed. validity and force.
- 2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Short title. Order Confirmation (Sheffield) Act 1948.

SCHEDULE.

CITY OF SHEFFIELD.

Provisional Order partially altering a local Act.

WHEREAS the lord mayor aldermen and citizens of the city of Sheffield acting by the council (in this Order called "the Corporation") are the local authority for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875 and there are in force in the said city the unrepealed provisions 8 & 9 Geo. 5. of the Sheffield Corporation Act 1918 (in this Order called "the local Act ") as altered by the Sheffield Order 1926 (in this Order called "the Order of 1926") which was confirmed by the Ministry of Health 16 & 17 Geo. 5. Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 6) Act 1926;

And whereas by section 234 of the local Act as altered by the order of 1926 the Corporation are empowered to charge in respect of their abattoir undertaking the sums specified in the Fifth Schedule to the local Act as altered by the Order of 1926;

And whereas the Corporation have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order further to alter the local Act in the manner following:—

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

Short title and commencement.

1. This Order may be cited as the Sheffield Order 1948 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Alteration of charges in respect of abattoir.

2. The local Act as altered by the Order of 1926 shall be further altered by the substitution for the sums specified in part (a) of the schedule to the Order of 1926 of the sums specified in the schedule to this Order.
